Flu and Coronavirus: Prevent the Spread by Social Distancing

Have you heard the term social distancing? This is intentionally limiting your interactions with others.

With the recent concerns about coronavirus, social distancing is a proven way to prevent spreading a virus. It's an especially great strategy in church where we are known to shake hands, hug and kiss others.

We encourage social distancing to combat the flu, so getting into the habit now will help us limit the spread of coronavirus, especially since it has now reached Louisiana.

Viruses travel on dust particles or small droplets when people talk, sneeze, cough, laugh or exhale. These droplets can land on others, as well as on things we touch such as books, microphones, podiums, tables and doorknobs, spreading the virus to others.

PREVENTION IS THE BEST TREATMENT: In addition to keeping your distance, wash your hands frequently. Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated. Cough or sneeze into your sleeve/elbow or tissue and discard the tissue. Get immunized - It's not too late to get a flu shot. Flu shots are available at the local health units and most local pharmacies at no cost with most insurance plans.


